

## G 'UNM' DESK by Nina Graziosi for Lensvelt

Nina Graziosi's 'UNM' (pronounced 'you and me') for Dutch office specialist Lensvelt is the result of the architect's research into an adaptable desk solution that can fit into any office environment, while allowing users to customise its specs. Minimal in its design, the desk features a modular composition, and its top can be adjusted, thanks to a mechanical cogwheel movement (pictured) that slides the worktop up and down the horizontal band around the desk. Craziosi's design lends itself to a variety of creative material arrangements, so, alongside traditional wood and polyester renditions, Lensvelt has decided to indulge in a more luxurious option, making the design out of precious marble and shiny copper.
